Futures for Youth Program

Reaching Independence Through Employment

The Futures for Youth program provides flexible and holistic services to support young Canadians between the ages of 15 and 30 to develop the skills and gain paid work experience to successfully transition into the labour market. Eligible individuals will be provided with a living allowance during workshop series while gaining the confidence and skills necessary to find and sustain meaningful employment.

Program Includes:

- Paid group-based workshop series for 5 weeks which includes: life and personal development skills, essential skills and employability skills training
- Weekly living allowance during workshop series for eligible participants
- Individualized employment counselling, vocational assessments and career coaching
- Up to 6 sessions with Psychologist or Registered Clinical Counsellor
- Transportation supports as eligible
- Paid work experience for participants
- Funding for occupational skills training, certifications, upgrading including supplies and books
- Job search techniques and support, including funding for work gear and/or tools
- Supportive, assistive and adaptive devices, equipment and technology as eligible

To participate in this program, individuals must be:

- ✓ between the ages of 15 and 30 (inclusive) at the time of intake;
- ✓ not enrolled in full-time studies or education
- ✓ a Canadian citizen, permanent resident or protected person as defined by the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act and legally entitled to work in Canada
